

INFORMED CONSENT
FOR IN-PERSON ATTENDANCE AT MASS
DURING COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH CRISIS

St. Paul's Parish intends as best it can to follow all mandated Archdiocesan safety protocols and county regulations for public worship services. However, the county medical officer has advised us that public gatherings may nevertheless present an increased possibility of contagion even if safety precautions are taken, and therefore he has asked us to inform you that your participation may increase the risk for yourself and your family.

The church cannot guarantee that there is no risk of infection for attendees. A gathering may increase your risk of contracting the virus, or if you do contract the virus it may have a greater chance of creating serious illness that could even result in death.

You should stay home:

- If you are over the age of 50 and have a chronic or underlying medical condition;
- If you fall into any high-risk category;
- If you feel sick;
- If you are displaying any COVID-19 symptoms especially fever, cough, or difficulty breathing;
- If any person in your household is displaying any symptoms.

Your signature below indicates that you understand these risks, that you acknowledge the risks involved, that you agree to follow any and all instructions given, and that you agree to abide by all safety protocols. This information will be kept confidential to the extent the law allows, and is protected from law enforcement and immigration authorities.
